

2022 GLOCK FOUNDATION GOLF OUTING

Golf Rules for Regular Golf

- Play must be with at least one partner to attest to the score taken for the round of golf. A player is responsible for the correctness of the score recorded for each hole on their score card. Individuals cannot golf alone and submit their scores.
- Men will use white tees. Women will use red tees. Men over 60 may use the gold (senior) tees if they wish. The same set of tees will be used for the entire round. There will be no switching of tee boxes during the round.
- The USGA Rules of Golf apply.
- Once on the green, players must hole out. There are no “gimmes”.
- No more than 10 strokes shall be taken on any hole.
- The Callaway Handicap System will be used to determine the final score of each player.
- When complete, send picture of scorecard with course name, location, player name, and date to tglock@glockfoundation.org.
- Prizes will be awarded to the low scoring individual and foursome.

Golf Rules for Miniature Golf

- Miniature golf must be played with at least one partner to attest to the score taken for the round of golf.
- Course selected must be at least 18 holes. If a course has more than 18 holes, the score will be based on the first 18 holes.
- Once on the green, players must hole out. There are no “gimmes”.
- When complete, send picture of scorecard with course name, course location, player name, and date to tglock@glockfoundation.org.
- Prizes will be awarded to the low scoring male and female.
